



WORKING WITH CHILDREN at QLS level 1

This programme is designed for people who wish to gain an understanding of the principles of working with children from birth to five years, and in supporting children's development in a variety of settings. It is intended as an introductory course and will enable students to progress to higher level qualifications required to work in the sector

Description

The objectives of the course are to enable those who support children's care activities to gain the skills to:

- Work effectively as part of a team
- Contribute to equality of opportunity in young children's development
- Provide a wide range of play activities

Study Method

The course is designed for study by distance learning at work or at home. Students receive course manual, assignments and studyguide plus tutor support by mail and email. You can start at any time and plan your studies over a period of up to one year from the time of enrolment.

Assessment

Each element is followed by a written assignment, which is submitted and marked by your tutor. There is no external examination required.

Unit 4: Contribute to the equality of opportunity in support of young children's development

- Understand own role in promoting children's rights
- Understand how to respond appropriately to the additional needs on individual children

- Understand the need to clear away activities with a group of young children
